


Porcelain Chipping


Veneer porcelain chipping is most frequently caused by inadequate finish following occlusal adjustments as illustrated below:




Occlusal high spot in need of adjustment



Adjustment carried out




Square edge corner created by adjustment poses risk of chipping




Part of veneer porcelain flakes off

Solution:



Adjustment carried out



It is imperative to round off & polish the adjusted area in order to prevent chipping
